

A New Era for CFDA

Throughout history our society has always had to make changes and adapt to what some call "progress" while others do not. As members of CFDA while we "Honor the Romance & Legend of the Old West", we must also accept that we live in current times, which also provides many modern benefits that we also cherish.

Newsprint is going the way of the Sears Catalog, the Telegraph, and the Pony Express. They're never coming back, except for reasons of nostalgia. They all had to make way for "progress"!

Newspapers have also been disappearing across the world giving way to online publications. Most newspapers had their own printing presses, and to keep staff busy between publications they served the public by printing periodicals like real estate handouts, community trading publications, and other items like our Gunslinger's Gazette.

We found out just 35 days before the deadline of this issue of the Gazette, that our printer was going out of business. This happened to us in 2013, and we quickly found a replacement, along with the huge benefit of going full color. This time we soon learned that there is no longer a newsprint publisher in Northern Nevada. We realized that even if we could find another newsprint source, we just couldn't depend on how long that too would last. So, we decided it was time to update our entire format.

Our first order of business was to publish our 11th Edition Gunslinger's Guidelines, which is produced every three years and was already in the editing process. So, we had to reformat immediately, after a solid week of editing, we put it out for review and proof-reading by our CFDA Regulator Posse. After printing it was mailed on February 3rd. You have received it by now. We hope you like it!

Now, with our first newly formatted Gunslinger's Gazette, that you're reading the hard copy or online, we hope that you like it!

What about future Gunslinger Gazettes? We've already had discussions here at CFDA Headquarters. Because of the shear cost of publishing, printing and mailing, there are things we must consider currently and in the future.

We discussed going totally online, but ruled that out since many of our members, including me, are of the generation that likes to read the real thing. But then again, we've also had a number of members request us not to send the Gazette, they actually prefer to read it online.

We believe it is extremely important to our organization to have reliable communication outlets, published, online, and social media.

CowboyFastDraw.com is our official website and the key window into our organization. For years, we have been publishing our Gunslinger's Gazette on our website as soon as we send it to our printer, so many of our members already read it online.

The **Gunslinger's Gazette** is a quarterly publication which is the *Official Journal of CFDA*. However, it is 3 months between publications. Perhaps it is time to also publish an official monthly CFDA Website "online" **Gunslinger's Bulletin**, just a page or two, with the latest news about Cowboy Fast Draw. We will consider that soon.

Cowboy Fast Draw Society - Facebook Group, is the best source for up to the minute information about CFDA, and our CFDA Family. We understand that many of our members avoid Facebook for various reasons, including Alotta Lead, I don't blame them, I don't like their politics either. Maybe another option will come soon. But until then, please consider that Facebook is free, and you don't really have to use it for anything except staying current with CFDA information.

Decisions So Far- The Gunslinger's Gazette will go on both a printed and online format. CFDA will absorb the extra cost at this time, however the Gazette will no longer be distributed as a *"Recruitment Tool"* the way we used to. In order to trim added expenses, we are implementing the following steps:

1. We are going back to our original policy of only mailing one Gunslinger's Gazette per household.

2. A few years ago we were forced to quit sending Gazettes outside of North America, due to the cost. After this issue, we will no longer send Gazettes to any member outside of the U.S.A.. They are available online to everyone.

3. We have already made refunds to any club that paid to have a bundle of Gazettes automatically shipped to them.

4. We are going to send a letter to many of our Life Members, some are active and some are not. We will ask them to confirm that they wish to keep receiving a hard copy of the Gunslinger's Gazette. If we don't hear back from them, we'll assume that they are either not active or wish to read their Gazette online.

5. In 2023, we may need to revisit our dues structure, and include discounts for those who opt out of receiving a hard copy of the Gunslingers' Gazette and desire to read it online.

We will still have CFDA brochures available to clubs as recruitment hand-outs, at no cost, except to cover the postage. They are available to Clubs at the CFDA General Store.

2022, Our 20th Anniversary of CFDA!

New Website Information- Soon we will began to improve and expand our collection of online informational videos and information on CowboyFastDraw.com.

Championship Buckles- We have switched our buckle provider and have developed a whole new look for our CFDA Championship Buckles. Beginning this year, while continuing to award our Overall Men's and Ladies Titled Champions, we are also adding CFDA Championship buckles to our Men & Ladies Resident Champions.

Deadwood- We are back in Deadwood, it's always nice to visit "Where it all began!"

FGA's New Indoor Venue- We are really excited to announce that we are now in contract with Churchill County Fairgrounds in Fallon, Nevada to hold this year's FGA with an expanded schedule. We'll post an updated schedule very soon!

What do you love most about Cowboy Fast Draw?

Every year at the end of FGA, it's almost hard to leave Fallon, because I know it is the beginning of the off-season and I just can't wait for the next season to start again. What inspired you to train to become a champion?

Since I was very young, I've always loved to compete. Because of my competitive drive I learn to adapt and learn from both my losses and wins. I've never been one to just show up and shoot, I come to win. But, even if I go out in just 4 rounds, I ask myself, what did I learn? How much do you practice? K.K.

I had to practice a lot when I was first learning. I really don't practice much anymore, I'm just too busy going to so many shoots. Nowadays, actual competition is my real training. I do

CFDA TOP GUN OF THE YEAR POINT SYSTEM

Each year CFDA conducts a year-end points race to determine the CFDA Top Gun of the Year. Shooters can accumulate points by attending and doing well in all CFDA Titled Championships. Each shooter's best highest 6 point totals will be tallied at the end of the year. Competitor tally must include their 2 best finishes in State Championships and any 4 others to establish their point total for the year. CFDA Awards the Top 10 Men and Women with belt buckles at the conclusion of the World Championship. Tie-breakers are determined by overall placing at the World Championship, where the season concludes each year. Any contests held after that date will apply to the following season. The following point values will apply:

(For finishes below 6th Place, points will diminish one point per overall place until exhausted)

Several years ago, I bought the cookbook "Aunt Bee's Mayberry Cookbook". It's a fantastic trip down memory lane, showcasing all the cast and crew that were connected to the show and its success for bringing joy into our living rooms for many years and to this day, still enjoying the antics of Goober, Barney and the rest of the gang. But bringing them all together was Aunt Bee's "suppers" at the end of the day!

Not only being a fun book to read it's full of "Mayberry" recipes from folks around the country! Here' one that I tried out. Seeing how it was wintery cold out one day, a "soup day" seemed to be in order! Called "Aunt Bee's Lentil Soup" ~ I tweaked it a bit to fit our taste - Super Easy, served with warm corn bread drowning in honey butter, it hits the spot! - Enjoy! Alotta Lead

Here's what Aunt Bee would have needed:

1-Lb of your favorite smoked sausage, sliced into small chunks

1 cup diced red or yellow onions

1 cup each diced celery & diced carrots

1/2 Teaspoon oregano –

 $\frac{1}{2}$ Teaspoon garlic salt

1 Tablespoon brown sugar *-like it a bit sweeter? Try a wee bit more brown sugar*

1 – small can tomato paste – 6oz can **-use only half can-3oz**...more if you want though

1- large can stewed to matoes (Italian flavored is super tasting in this soup) - 20 oz can

1 pack of Onion Soup mix

1 ¹/₂ Lbs. Dried Lentils

8 cups water

Season to your liking.....more onion soup mix, more garlic, a bit of black pepper.....

Add all ingredients in a large stock pot EXCEPT the tomato paste & stewed tomatoes. Cook for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

Add all canned tomato items and simmer for another 30-45 minutes-As Andy would say... "Mighty Fine Aunt Bee – Mighty Fine"!





It is up to the purchaser to choose their FFL Dealer and instruct them to FAX (775) 575-5748) or email (info@cowboyfastdraw.com) a copy of their FFL to us. After receiving payment we will then ship the firearm to your FFL Dealer, who will then be responsible to have you fill out the appropriate forms and conduct a background check, according to Federal and your State Laws and Regulations.

The buyer is responsible to pay all transfer fees, background checks directly to their FFL Dealer of choice.

All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned to CFDA only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. 

THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

24" Round Plate - 50" Height to Center - Start Light in Center 17-3/16" Rnd Plate - 47" Height to Center - Start Light in Center

17-3/4" Balloon-Disc - 47" Height to Center - See Specs White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Westernstyle blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to *educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms.* Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.

To keep our clothing & equipment such as guns and holsters true to form of the time period that we represent (1873-1899). 1873 is the year that the Colt Peacemaker was introduced.


